Once you have paid your subs the Secretary will send you an acknowledgement and also the most recent documents and emails that have been sent out to Members, so that you are as up to date as possible.

We communicate with members via email, as the quickest and most efficient method. We keep our emails to a minimum and only send the following to enable you to get maximum benefit from your Club membership:

- Three emails per year that includes the walk programme for the next 4 months and a Club newsletter.
- Occasional emails giving information deemed relevant to members eg. Map reading courses, walking holiday opportunities, social events, annual subs reminder.
